December 31st, 2014 - Although cancer in children is rare it is the leading cause of death by disease past infancy among children in the United States In 2018 it is estimated that 15 590 children and adolescents ages 0 to 19 will be diagnosed with cancer and 1 780 will die of the disease in the United States Among children ages 0 to 14 years it is estimated that in 2018 10 590 will be diagnosed with cancer
